- Coordinate periodic forecasting activities, analyzing variances and making recommendations as required;
- Provide financial analysis and strategic insight to senior management to support decision-making;
- Evaluate financial reporting systems and accounting procedures, recommending enhancements to improve efficiency, accuracy, and financial controls;
- Evaluate and execute accounting and internal control systems, ensuring internal approval procedures are followed;
- Monitor and safeguard company assets;
- Perform other accounting and administrative tasks as required; and
- Understand, comply and promote all company policies and procedures including reporting of hazards and incidents encountered in daily operations.

- A minimum of five years of progressive experience in accounting, auditing, financial planning and analysis, preferably in the private sector;

- Close attention to detail to ensure accuracy;
- Ability to balance multiple tasks and priorities, ensuring timely and accurate reporting;
- Analytical and problem solving skills, with the ability to translate financial data into strategies and action;
